Abstract Submission Guidelines

Eligibility

Abstracts may be submitted by:

- Postgraduate students
- Senior Residents / Fellows
- Faculty members
- Practicing Consultants
- Researchers and allied healthcare professionals

The presenting author must register for ISICPM 2026.

PG students would be able to register at special discounted rates.

Faculty members and Practicing consultants would be allowed early bird registration rates

Categories

Original Research

- Clinical research
- Observational studies
- Randomized controlled trials
- Quality improvement projects
- Educational research

Case Report

- Rare cases
- Novel management approaches
- Unique complications
- Significant learning points

Case Series

- Series of patients with similar clinical findings or interventions

Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts must be original and unpublished.
- Work previously presented at another conference should be clearly disclosed.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- Abstracts should be submitted through the ISICPM 2026 abstract portal before the submission deadline.
- Multiple abstracts may be submitted by the same author.
- The Scientific Committee reserves the right to assign accepted abstracts to oral or poster presentations.

For Case Reports

Title
Authors and Affiliations
Introduction
Case Description: This can be pasted half each in Methods and Results section in the online format
Discussion
Keywords (maximum 5)
References (maximum 3, Vancouver style)

Tables and Figures

- Maximum **one figure, image, graph or table** may be attached in the supporting file
- A descriptive caption/legend must accompany the figure or table.
- Images should be of high resolution.

Author Information

Please provide:

- Full title of abstract
- Full names of all authors
- Department and Institution
- Presenting author's email address
- Presenting author's mobile number

Review Process

All submissions will undergo **peer review** by the Scientific Committee based on:

- Scientific merit
- Originality
- Methodological quality
- Clinical relevance
- Clarity of presentation

The decision of the Scientific Committee shall be final.

Publication

Accepted abstracts may be:

- Published in the conference abstract book/e-book.
- Displayed on the conference website.
- Included in conference proceedings.

Submission of an abstract implies consent for publication by ISICPM.

Certificate

All presenters will receive:

- Certificate of Presentation
- Participation certificate as applicable

These may be utilized for academic and NMC-related documentation as per prevailing regulations.

Ethical Requirements

For studies involving human participants:

- Institutional Ethics Committee approval number should be mentioned where applicable.

- Informed consent should have been obtained wherever required.
- Authors must disclose any conflict of interest and funding source.
